3rd Annual UU Road Rally – TEAM INFORMATION SHEET

Hello. You are receiving this information as a member of a team registered for this Road Rally.

Your team includes: Team Member 1; Team Member 2; Team Member 3; Team Member 4.

You are **TEAM** # ____ and your START TIME is ____: ___ AM. Start Location = Middleboro Town Hall

<u>Thank you for being a part of this fun event!</u> We hope you have a great time. If any member of your team has not yet been listed on your registration form and signed the release, they will need to do that at the Registration Desk on Rally Day, Saturday October 21. Try to fill out your team with 4 members. The Rally is very difficult with only a Driver and a Navigator. 3 people is better. 4 gives your team its best chance.

PLEASE PLAN to arrive at the Town Hall parking lot so you can be at the Rally Registration Table 15 minutes before your START TIME. You will then receive:

- A number placard for your vehicle. Place this on your vehicle dashboard.
- 2 sets of Directions/Questions.
 - 1. One set must be turned in when you finish the Rally Route. This is used for Scoring and must contain your team's <u>final answers to the Rally Point Questions</u>.
 - 2. The other set may be retained by your team. You may want to use this as a record of how your team did and as an aid to remembering how your team answered the questions.

An Official Answer Sheet will be posted at the end of the Rally so you may compare your team's time, distance and answers to the Official numbers and answers. When your Directions/Questions are in hand, your team **may begin reading** through the directions **and answering** the clues in black.

Dos and Don'ts:

- **Do make sure** you know how to set your vehicle's trip meter to "0" for start of Rally.
- Do bring GPS, clipboards, pens, pencils and anything else you may like to have in hand as you do Rally
- Do use GPS if you have it as it will help you anticipate turns. Remember: Follow all traffic laws.
- **Do strategize:** Where will your navigator and clue sleuths sit?

Scoring: The course has been run many times to determine the Official "Target time" and "Target mileage". This is not revealed until the Rally is over. Officials will assess 1 penalty point for each second the Target Time is missed, and 10 penalty points for each 1/10th mile the Target distance is missed. Correct answers to Point Questions earns your team 15 points each. Is your team willing to sacrifice time to get more Point Questions?

At the FINISH line, as soon as your time and mileage are noted by an Official, move forward to make room for the next team. You will then have ONE MINUTE to give a Rally Official the sheets with your final answers to the point questions. Your team keeps the other copy. Be sure to park out of the way and then go across the street to the UU for snacks and entertainment. The UU restrooms will be available.

Relax and enjoy a friendly conversation or an excited recounting of your Rally experience as the rest of the Rally TEAMS finish the course. Once all Teams are done and the Officials have calculated the scores, trophies will be awarded. If your TEAM doesn't win, just wait until next year!

Notes: In the event of a tie, the 1st tie breaker will be time, then mileage. Rally Officials decisions are final.
